We have made our final decision regarding class groupings for the 2021 school year.

It is vital that families who are leaving Corpus Christi advise us immediately so we can plan accordingly.

At this stage due to the disruption of COVID-19 throughout 2020, we anticipate there will be NO change to current class groupings.

After discussion with educational psychologists and experts, ALL children will remain with their current teacher for 2021 to ensure student wellbeing and continuity, and to assist with a smooth transition to 2021.

We are extremely fortunate at Corpus Christi Primary School to have a group of wonderfully talented,

dedicated and committed teachers and staff. We ask all children and parents to continue to support us through your continued cooperation and positive attitude to learning.

2021 TERM DATES

Staff will return on Wednesday 27th January 2021.

Thursday 28th and Friday 29th have been set aside as testing for Literacy and Numeracy.

Year 1 to 6 Children will be timetabled to attend school for 2 hours for individual/small group testing.

Foundation children will attend 9.00am - 11.0am on Thursday 28th and Friday 29th January.

All children will commence school 8.50am on Monday 1st February.

2021 FEES

As costs (gas, electricity, insurance, maintenance, gardening, technology support, cleaning, etc) continue to increase in providing educational resources and facilities we annually have to schedule a fee increase to meet the ongoing cost of providing Catholic Education in the Glenroy Parish. We have tried to keep the fee increase minimal (but realistic in meeting our financial needs) so as not to increase financial hardship on families.

Due to the financial impact of COVID-19 in 2021 we have NOT increased Tuition Fee per child in 2021. An overall \$10 increase on Family Fee will be implemented for 2021. This is an average increase of 25 cents per week over the school year.

If experiencing any financial difficult please contact School Office to make an appointment to discus the situation. Thank you for your continued cooperation and understanding.



ROAD SAFETY

Children should always enter the car from the **safety of the curb using the passenger side door**. Children should not walk onto the road to enter the car. Please ensure that children wear seatbelts at all times.

PLEASE do not DOUBLE Park when collecting or dropping off children.

A reminder to parents that parents and children should use the crossing in Cromwell St rather than walk out from between parked cars. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT CHILDREN'S SAFETY

CHILDREN'S MOBILE PHONES/SMART WATCHES

We understand the need for parents and children to contact each other before or after school hours in emergency situations.

We request that if children require a mobile phone/smart watch at school that Mr Lucardie be advised in writing and that the children check the phone (clearly labelled with their name and class) in at the School Office for safe keeping.

Phones/smart watches should not be worn or kept in school bags or classrooms as they can be lost, damaged or stolen.

Children are not permitted to use mobile phones/smart phones to make or receive phone call during school hours.

Some children have been found playing with them at recess and lunchtime. Children should be made aware that they must be responsible in using their phones/smart watches at all time.
