Dear Families and Friends,

Thank you for your continued wonderful support and enthusiasm as we navigate the challenges of a COVID Safe return onsite.

As we move towards the end of the year we turn our minds to Advent and the preparation for Jesus' birth, a time of prayer, reflection and waiting. Be kind and gentle to yourselves! And others!

Masks for Year 3-6 students: We kindly ask that parents please ensure they have provided their children with enough masks so they can wear them inside each day as mandated by the government. Having extra masks in your child's bag may help with this. **(F-3 still strongly encouraged to wear masks)**

Reports: As per last year in Term 4, our Semester 2 reports have been adjusted to accommodate and reflect the remote learning scenario experienced in Semester 2. Schools have been given directives from MACS as to what to include in the Semester 2 report.

It is also important that we all continue to be vigilant and monitor our own and the health of our children, as families have advised me that they or personal close contacts have tested positive outside the school setting and are currently isolating.

If we have a confirmed school related positive COVID case families, will be advised of isolation and testing requirements required before they are able to return to school.

Fingers crossed we can stay COVID free through following mask wearing, physically distancing and hygiene and sanitizing practices. If you or your **child develops any symptoms:** (eg. Fever or chills, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose or anosmia (Loss of smell/taste)).

- Stay at home and do not attend school
- Seek medical advice/medical clearance before returning to school
- Call the school to let us know.

We ask all children and parents to continue to support us through your continued cooperation and positive attitude to learning.

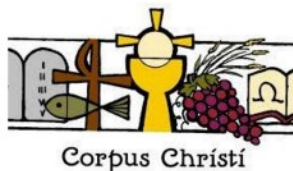
Families will be notified of their child's 2022 classroom teachers when they receive their child's end of year report.

The following criteria are used as a guideline for formulating class groupings.

- 1) Awareness of positive social/friendship groups.
- 2) Potential Behavioral/personality conflicts
- 3) Maturity/independent working ability
- 4) Gender Balance where possible
- 5) Level balance in multi-age groupings
- 6) Maximum two consecutive years with teacher
- 7) Academic balance
- 8) Parental involvement and support
- 9) Number of new arrivals / ESL /Children with special learning needs.

Sacrament of Eucharist (Holy Communion)

Sunday 28th November

How wonderful it is to have the restrictions lifted and so many Victorians vaccinated allowing us to enjoy the company of family and friends and to be able to celebrate important events.

As you are all aware the journey of your child/ children to receiving the sacrament of First Eucharist, began in May this year. After several false starts, I am pleased to announce the new date;
SUNDAY 28th November at 2:00 pm.

DRESS

Traditionally at Corpus Christi, girls wear white dresses or clothing suitable for a formal event, and boys wear a suit (optional) or neat casual clothes – dress pants and shirt with a collar. **No jeans, torn pants, runners, T/shirts or tracksuit pants.**

PHOTOS

We are looking to book School Pix to take the photos for the Sacrament of Eucharist. I am awaiting confirmation as to what time the candidates will need to be arriving at the school hall for their photos. Each candidate will have three photos taken:

1. A portrait- taken in the hall
2. A photo of the candidate receiving the Body of Christ.
3. A group photo on the altar at the end of the Mass with Father Giang.

The candidates are to remain in the hall until 1.40 pm at which time the group will walk over to the church and be seated in readiness for the start of the Mass. **PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE!**

School Pix will provide the school with flyers for each candidate, one week before the Mass. The flyer will provide details of the procedure for viewing, ordering and paying for your photos online.

No money is to be handed to the school and all correspondence about the photos is with School Pix.

We kindly ask that no video or digital cameras are to be used during Mass.

PREPARATION DAY

Unfortunately, due to Covid-19 restrictions, there will not be a full day of preparation for First Eucharist. However, on **Friday 26th of November 2021 at 2.15 pm** the children preparing for the Sacrament of Holy Communion will go to the church for a practice in the afternoon.

CHURCH LIMITS

There is a great news. From midnight Thursday 18 Nov. Covid-19 restrictions are lifted for the **fully vaccinated**. There is no capacity limits or density limits in the church.

Therefore, **all vaccinated people are welcome for the First Reconciliation and Holy Communion celebrations.**

No mask is required in the church, but people are free to wear if they wish.

For those who attend Mass must provide proof of vaccination before entering the Church either in digital or paper form. ALL are encouraged to come to Church at least 30 to 15 minutes before start of Mass to avoid long queues and to expedite QR Code and vaccination checks. Church doors will close FIVE minutes before Mass starts. **NO entry after this time.**



TERM FOUR FEES

Due to COVID 19 Restrictions Administration would prefer fees processed by Electronic Funds Transfer.

Fees are able to be manually processed CASH payments of FEES as long as parents strictly adhere to Office density limit and use QR Codes.

Fee accounts have been sent out at the start of Term 4. Final payment due by Tuesday 30th November

2022 FEES

As costs (gas, electricity, insurance, maintenance, gardening, technology support, cleaning, etc) continue to increase in providing educational resources and facilities we annually have to schedule a fee increase to meet the ongoing cost of providing Catholic Education in the Glenroy Parish. We have tried to keep the fee increase minimal (but realistic in meeting our financial needs) so as not to increase financial hardship on families.

We have been advised by our Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools (MACS) Business Manager that we are required to increase our 2022 Fees as indicated below.

SCHOOL ARRANGEMENTS

PLEASE continue to discuss safe hygiene practices (hand sanitising, washing hands, physical distancing, no touching other people's property, etc.) with your child while we resume onsite learning.

We request parents are punctual with daily drop off between 8.30am and 8.55am (even on Wednesdays until the end of Term 4) and at designated staggered pickup time (either 3.10 or 3.30pm) at designated gates (see next page).

Please do not be late to assist us with orderly and safe dismissal.

Alternatively, children need to be enrolled in EXTEND OUTER Hours Care.

Gates will open at 8.30-8.55am daily.

Children **ARE NOT to be left unaccompanied** outside school gates before 8.30am. If children need to be dropped off before 8.30am they **MUST** register and book into **EXTEND Before School Care**.

ALL children are required to **bring a personal Water Bottle** (clearly labelled).

If a child or staff member registers a HIGH TEMPERATURE and/or displaying cold or flu like symptoms (sore throat, runny nose, cough, breathing difficulties) **they will be excluded from attending school until they receive a doctor's clearance.**

If one member of the family household (parents, grandparents or children) is unwell, then all siblings are required to stay home.

It is extremely important parents or emergency contacts are readily available and contactable in the event that children need to be sent home. **Phone numbers need to be current. Please update.**

Adults other than staff or contractors will not be permitted onsite. i.e.

NO classroom helpers, NO Canteen (CLOSED until end of TERM 4), NO Uniform Shop.

Please follow physical distancing guides when waiting for children to be collected along Cromwell St and Melbourne Ave (X marks the spot!)

There will be NO borrowing of Library books.

We request no pick up of students at break times (. Please advise Office/ Classroom teacher if you your child is to be collected early for an appointment.

Our primary goal is to provide a safe and hygienic learning space for all members of our Corpus Christi Community (children, staff and families). Thank you.

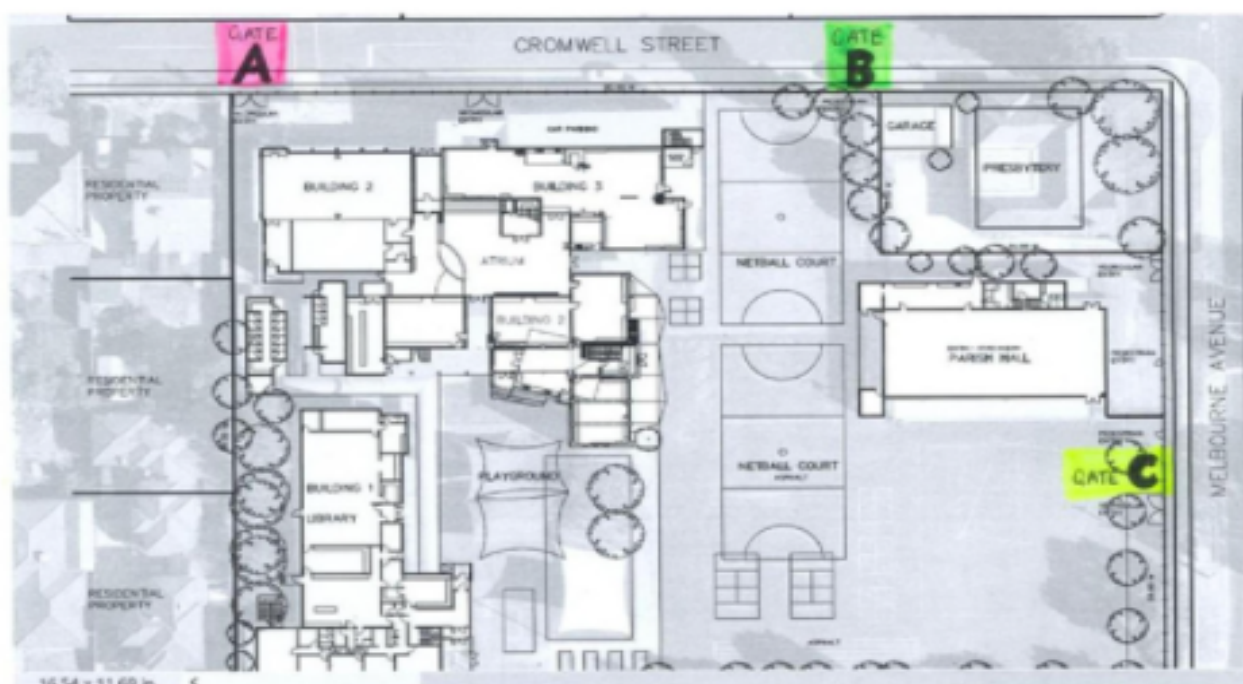

REMINDER “Runners” are not part of our daily school uniform.

Sports shorts, netball skirts or tracksuits are worn.



ROAD SAFETY

Children should always enter the car from the **safety of the curb using the passenger side door**. Children should not walk onto the road to enter the car. Please ensure that children wear seatbelts at all times.



**PLEASE do not DOUBLE Park
when collecting or dropping off children.**

A reminder to parents that parents and children should use the crossing in Cromwell St rather than walk out from between parked cars. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Your assistance in ensuring your children follow correct safety procedures will help avoid a serious or even fatal accident.

SEVERE FOOD ALLERGIES

We have a number of children who have life threatening food allergies. We ask all parents to **discuss with their children correct disposal of uneaten lunches, not to share food with other children and to practise good hygiene habits** (ie. washing hands before and after eating).

CHILDREN'S MOBILE PHONES/SMART WATCHES

We understand the need for parents and children to contact each other before or after school hours in emergency situations.

We request that if children require a **mobile phone/smart watch at school that Mr Lucardie be advised in writing** and that the **children check the phone (clearly labelled with their name and class) in at the School Office for safe keeping.**

Phones/smart watches should not be worn or kept in school bags or classrooms as they can be lost, damaged or stolen.

Children are not permitted to use mobile phones/smart phones to make or receive phone call during school hours.

Some children have been found playing with them at recess and lunchtime.

Children should be made aware that they must be responsible in using their phones/smart watches at all time.
