Level Crossing Removal Works - Widford Street new bus stop construction:

As a part of the Glenroy Road level crossing removal project works, two westbound bus stop on Melbourne Avenue will be removed and combined into a **new bus stop** with a new raised pedestrian crossing **on Widford Street.**

Last week of Term 1, from 7am Monday 4 April to 3pm Saturday 9 April;

- Widford Street eastern footpath will be closed near Melbourne Avenue. Pedestrians can detour via the western footpath.
- Four car spaces on the western side of Widford Street will be temporarily removed.
- The intersection of Widford Street and Glenroy Road will be closed between 9pm and 5am

First week of school holidays, from 7am Monday 11 April to 6pm Thursday 14 April;

- Widford Street will be closed to traffic south of the Melbourne Avenue roundabout
- Melbourne Avenue westbound lane will be closed at the Widford Street roundabout
- Widford Street eastern footpath will be closed. Pedestrians can detour via the western footpath.

Traffic controllers will be in place to guide vehicles, and help pedestrians cross the street during construction.

- The new Glenroy Station will be open from Saturday 7 May, access from Hartington Street.

Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools COVID-19 Vaccinations – Parents and Carers on School Sites Guidelines

Purpose of these guidelines and commencement

The purpose of these guidelines is to outline the required process for Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools (MACS) education facilities to manage MACS' vaccination requirements relating to parents, carers and other visitors not performing work on school sites.

These guidelines commence with immediate effect and operate until further notice.

Vaccination requirements for parents, carers and other visitors not performing work

All parents, carers and other visitors attending schools, including for drop-off and pick-up, must adhere to physical distancing, density limits and face mask requirements, and practise respiratory etiquette and good hand hygiene.

Schools must sight vaccination information of parents, carers and other adult visitors not performing work who enter school buildings (excluding students who visit a school to complete a secondary school subject, such as a VET subject). Schools do not need to collect, record or hold the information in these circumstances.

Parents, carers and other adult visitors (excluding students who visit a school to complete a secondary school subject) who enter school buildings must have had two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine or have a valid medical exception, with the following limited exceptions:

- when attending to administer medical treatment to their own child where the treatment cannot be administered by the school
- * when attending to collect their child who is unwell and cannot leave the school building unaccompanied by their parent/carer
- when attending for a momentary period that does not involve any sustained contact with staff or students, for example, to collect a completed art project or similar.

Parents, carers and other adult visitors attending school sites for drop-off and pick-up who do not enter school buildings do not need to comply with vaccination requirements. Parents, carers and other adult visitors attending a gathering at school, such as a fete, school play or other school ceremony, whether indoors or outdoors, need to show evidence of vaccination on arrival.

When parents and carers do not meet vaccination requirements, the school should hold meetings and other discussions (such as Student Support Group meetings) virtually. Schools should advise external providers who use or hire school facilities outside school hours that they are responsible for ensuring the use aligns with the Open Premises Order including vaccination requirements.

Medically excepted persons

In line with the Mandatory Vaccination Orders, parents, carers and visitors may be able to show that they are an 'excepted person'.



ROAD SAFETY

Children should always enter the car from the safety of the curb using the passenger side door. Children should not walk onto the road to enter the car. Please ensure that children wear seatbelts at all times.

PLEASE do not DOUBLE Park

when collecting or dropping off children.

Healthcare Card holders are eligible to apply for the CSEF allowance (currently \$125) which is deducted from the Tuition Fee. Forms at Office. We will structure our payment schedule to enable families to budget for fee payments.

SUNCARE POLICY - NO HAT! NO PLAY!!

All children are to wear our Corpus Christi Sun Hat for protection from the sun when involved in any outdoor activities (eg sport, games, play/lunch time) Children without the school sunhat will be required to remain under the shade of the covered ways. Sun hats are available from the Parents' Association Uniform Shop. Children are advised to apply sunscreen as well.

Sunglasses are recommended for outside activities.

SEVERE FOOD ALLERGIES

We have a number of children who have life threatening food allergies. We ask all parents to discuss with their children correct disposal of uneaten lunches, not to share food with other children and to practise good hygiene habits (ie. washing hands before and after eating).

YEAR SEVEN 2024 ENROLMENT CLOSING DATE (Year 5 students)

Year 5 children enrolling for Year 7 Catholic Secondary School (eg Penola Catholic College in 2024) must have enrolment forms returned to their relevant secondary school by August 2022. Enrolments now still open for Year7 2023

"NO SHOW-LET US KNOW!"

In light of Victorian Government attendance guideline requirements, following an incident at a school late 2017, of a child hiding in their parent's car all day, unbeknown to the parent, resulting in serious heat related injuries, we are continuing our current practice of contacting parents to ensure the safe arrival at school of all children, especially those children who walk or ride to school without adult supervision.

If your child is absent from school we request you inform our School Office of their non-attendance by **9.00am** on the day of absence using the following methods

If your child is marked as absent on the daily roll and we have not been notified, we will contact families to ensure that children are still at home. Your assistance will ensure we don't need to make time consuming or unnecessary phone calls.

Children arriving after 9.00am must report to the School Office to obtain a late pass and have their attendance adjusted from absent to present.
