A pop-up COVID-19 vaccination clinic will be held in the School Hall on: Friday 6th May (3pm – 7pm) Saturday 7th May (10am – 3pm)

Parking will be available on the school grounds, enter through gate C.

Students and their families (current and future), in addition to general community members, are strongly encouraged to visit the pop-up vaccination clinic during the designated times.

Eligibility

Vaccinations will be available to all staff, students, their families and other local community members.

What to bring

Students and families should bring the following to the pop-up clinic:

- a face mask
- photo identification
- a Medicare number or Individual Healthcare Identifier number, if you have one.

Please speak to your doctor if you have any questions about vaccination and your child and your own individual health circumstances.

Consent

As a parent or carer, you can complete a <u>consent from for COVID-19 vaccination</u> for your child to take with them, or you can attend with your child to provide consent in person.

Students can consent to vaccination themselves if a health professional assesses them to be a mature minor. That is that the health professional assesses that they understand the information relevant to the decision to be vaccinated and the effect of that decision.

More information

If you and your child cannot attend the pop-up vaccination clinic, you can book and receive your COVID -19 vaccine at a state vaccination centre, Commonwealth vaccination centre, participating GP clinics, pharmacies or community health services.

You and your child can find a participating Commonwealth vaccination centre, GP, pharmacy or community health service through the <u>Vaccine Clinic Finder</u>. You can book your appointment online or by calling the vaccine provider nearest to you.

Workers and Volunteers in Schools under the Pandemic (Workplace) Order 2022 (No. 8) We can now clarify that education workers include volunteers that attend an education facility and that work in close proximity to children, students, parents or staff.

This includes Parent Helpers, Uniform Shop, Canteen /Tuckshop assistants, Classroom helpers, Excursion supervisors or classroom or working bee volunteers.

As such, any volunteer performing any work at a school is as an education worker, and they must be fully vaccinated (boosted).

By involving young people, the program allows for strong bonds to be formed to carry on the veteran's legacy. The Adopt an Ex-Service Organisation Program will ensure the memories of veterans and their service groups live on through citizens of the future.

Our ex-Service Group is **22 Squadron**, **Royal Australian Air Force**. They participated in the defence of Australia during World War II.

Our Year 6 Student Leaders, participated in a guided tour of the Shrine of Remembrance and

Annual Pilgrimage and Wreath Laying Ceremony for 22 Squadron on Thursday 28th April at the Shrine of Remembrance in St. Kilda Road. This event continues to acknowledge the work 22 Squadron did in defending Australia during World War 2, as there are no longer any living members of the Squadron residing in Melbourne.








ROAD SAFETY

SUNCARE POLICY - NO HAT! NO PLAY!!

All children are to wear our Corpus Christi Sun Hat for protection from the sun when involved in any outdoor activities (eg sport, games, play/lunch time) Children without the school sunhat will be required to remain under the shade of the covered ways. Sun hats are available from the Parents' Association Uniform Shop. Children are advised to apply sunscreen as well.

Sunglasses are recommended for outside activities.

SEVERE FOOD ALLERGIES

We have a number of children who have life threatening food allergies. We ask all parents to discuss with their children correct disposal of uneaten lunches, not to share food with other children and to practise good hygiene habits (ie. washing hands before and after eating).

YEAR SEVEN 2024 ENROLMENT CLOSING DATE (Year 5 students)

Year 5 children enrolling for Year 7 Catholic Secondary School (eg Penola Catholic College in 2024) must have enrolment forms returned to their relevant secondary school by August 2022. Enrolments now still open for Year7 2023








"NO SHOW-LET US KNOW!"

In light of Victorian Government attendance guideline requirements, following an incident at a school late 2017, of a child hiding in their parent's car all day, unbeknown to the parent, resulting in serious heat related injuries, we are continuing our current practice of contacting parents to ensure the safe arrival at school of all children, especially those children who walk or ride to school without adult supervision.

If your child is absent from school we request you inform our School Office of their non-attendance by **9.00am** on the day of absence using the following methods

If your child is marked as absent on the daily roll and we have not been notified, we will contact families to ensure that children are still at home. Your assistance will ensure we don't need to make time consuming or unnecessary phone calls.
