
To enable us to predict our enrolment figure for **2023** and assist us with planning class organization, it is important that we know your **intentions** for your family for **2023**.

## **Feast of Corpus Christi Thursday 16th June**



The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, historically known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi, celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist-Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

It is traditionally on the Thursday following the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity (this year Thursday 16th June) and celebrated in our Parish on the following Sunday 19th June 2022.

The feast dates to the Middle Ages and originated with a visionary nun and a Eucharistic miracle.
