TERM 1 SWIMMING PROGRAM

Due to Fawkner Leisure Centre undergoing renovations from April until the end of 2023 we will be conducting our annual five day swimming this term from on -



Monday 27th March, Tuesday 28th March, Wednesday 29th March, Thursday 30th March, & Friday 31st March at the Fawkner Leisure Centre 79-83 Jukes Rd Fawkner.

This is an intensive swimming program whereby the children attend swimming each day for 5 days.

Instructors may conduct some lessons in the outdoor pool at Fawkner Leisure Centre. Children should ensure they have sunscreen and appropriate sun protection if advised by their instructor that they will be swimming outdoors. (eg Rash vest/Tee shirt).



Each child exiting primary school is required to have a minimum level of attainment recommended by the swimming and water safety industry, and if so will be issued with a "Victorian Water Safety Certificate".

Water safety and swimming is a part of the Health and Physical Education curriculum. Foundation—Children are introduced to basic safety and survival procedures in and around the water.

Years 1 and 2 – Children explore different ways to move into, through, and out of water safely.

Years 3 and 4 – Children develop their knowledge and understanding of water safety, and extend their swimming and survival abilities.

Years 5 and 6 – Children improve their survival abilities and safety techniques in the water, extending their range of swimming skills to include those required for clothed, survival swimming. The aim of educating the children with regards to swimming and water safety is to enable them to safely enjoy aquatic activities in a range of environments.

Each child in the school is expected to attend swimming classes, a medical certificate will be required or you will need to see Mr. Lucardie to be granted an exemption. If your child is granted an exemption, they will still be expected to attend the Fawkner Leisure Centre, where they will be supervised by their classroom teacher. This is to alleviate the pressure on school organization and supervision.

If your child has private swimming lessons please ask the swimming centre, where your child attends, to issue them with a certificate stating their current level of swimming competence.

LENTEN SEASON

Easter is one of the most important Christian holidays, commemorating the resurrection of Jesus Christ after his crucifixion. It is celebrated on the first Sunday after the first full moon following the vernal equinox, which falls between March 22 and April 25.

Lent, on the other hand, is a period of 40 days leading up to Easter, during which Christians engage in prayer, fasting, and self-denial. It begins on Ash Wednesday, which is marked by the application of ashes on the forehead in the shape of a cross, as a symbol of repentance and mourning for sins.

The season of Lent is a time for Christians to reflect on their faith and relationship with God. Through prayer, fasting, and acts of charity, they seek to grow closer to God and to prepare themselves for the joyous celebration of Easter. Lent is also a time for repentance, as Christians acknowledge their sins and seek forgiveness through the sacrament of confession. Many churches hold special services and events during Lent, including stations of the cross, penitential services, and retreats.

Ash Wednesday, March 22nd, 2023, marked the beginning of Lent, and the ashes applied during Mass as a reminder of our humanity and the need to turn away from sin. It is a solemn occasion, but also a time of hope and renewal. As Christians begin their Lenten journey, they are reminded of the sacrifice that Jesus made on the cross and the promise of eternal life that is offered to all who believe in him. Easter is the culmination of this journey, a celebration of the triumph of life over death, and the ultimate victory of love over sin. "In his message for Lent 2023, Pope Francis encourages Catholics to listen to what Jesus wants to tell them through the Scriptures and through others.

"NO SHOW-LET US KNOW!"

In light of Victorian Government attendance guideline requirements, following an incident at a school late 2017, of a child hiding in their parent's car all day, unbeknown to the parent, resulting in serious heat related injuries, we are continuing our current practice of contacting parents to ensure the safe arrival at school of all children, especially those children who walk or ride to school without adult supervision.
