Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic School EBA Time in lieu

The new Catholic Education Multi-Enterprise Agreement 2022 (the Agreement) introduces a formal time in lieu (TIL) process for teachers. The Agreement provides that a principal may require a teacher to undertake work and attend a school activity outside the normal hours of attendance (i.e., in excess of the 38 hours or normal hours for a part-time teacher) and when this occurs, it will attract TIL.


Principals are to prepare for the accrual and acquittal of TIL through their annual planning process. The timing of the acquittal of TIL is at the discretion of the principal, having regard to the operational needs of the school and causing the least disruption to the educational program of the school. Principals may elect to acquit TIL through designating days during the year on which all staff and students are not required to attend school. For 2023, there are opportunities to acquit TIL for the whole school on the following days: April 24 (day before ANZAC Day); November 6 (day before Cup Day); early finishes on the last days of Terms 1, 2 and 3; end of Term 4 from Monday 18 December. Please note that no primary school students should be dismissed from schools prior to 15 December 2023 – this is their earliest finish date.

School Gates will now close at 3.40pm daily. After 3.40pm children collected from Office.

YEAR 2024 FOUNDATION (Prep) ENROLMENTS

Enrolments for children eligible to start school in Foundation in the Year 2024 are now open until the end of Term Two To be eligible to enrol children must turn five by 30th April 2024.

Copies of Baptism, Birth and Immunisation Certificates must be presented to the School Office. Further information and enrolment forms may be obtained from the School Office during school hours (8.30am - 4.00pm).

Year 6 Student Leaders attending 22 SQUADRON

Since 2009, Corpus Christi School has participated in the 'Adopt and Ex-Service Organisation Education Program at Melbourne's Shrine of Remembrance.

This program is aimed at developing permanent relationships between schools and ex-service groups. As veterans age, they are finding it increasingly difficult to conduct commemorative activities.

By involving young people, the program allows for strong bonds to be formed to carry on the veteran's legacy. The Adopt an Ex-Service Organisation Program will ensure the memories of veterans and their service groups live on through citizens of the future.

Our ex-Service Group is 22 Squadron, Royal Australian Air Force. They participated in the defense

of Australia during World War II.


