It has been a wonderful and positive start to the 2024 School Year.



SCHOOL UNIFORM SHOP

Parents' Association Uniform Shop will be open Wednesdays (8:45-9:15am) AND Fridays (3:15-3:45pm) only.

The Uniform Shop is located near the Atrium Entrance from the Big Yard and next to Foundation/1 CH class. Please ensure your child is in the correct uniform at all times. Runners should only be worn on your child's sports day unless otherwise notified. If your child is out of uniform a note explaining the reason would be appreciated.

A reminder 'Runners' are not part of our daily school uniform. Black school shoes should be worn on non-sports days.

SKATEBOARDS/BIKES/SCOOTERS

A number of children use skateboards, scooters or bikes to travel to school. We request skateboard, scooter and bike users wear a helmet and appropriate safety gear (e.g. knee pads, elbow & wrist supports).

2024 CORPUS CHRISTI SCHOOL FEES & LEVIES

Unfortunately as costs of living continue to increase in providing educational resources and facilities MACS have had to schedule a fee increase to meet the ongoing cost of providing Catholic Education in the Glenroy Parish. In consultation with our Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic School (MACS) Finance Business Partner we have tried to keep the fee increase minimal (but realistic in meeting our financial needs) so as not to increase financial hardship on families. An overall increase of 5% will be implemented for 2024. Thank you for your continued cooperation and understanding.

TUITION LEVY FEE FAMILY SCHOOL FEE

\$385 per student \$960 Family school Fee 2024 Year 5/6 Camp will be held at Don Bosco Camp at Safety Beach and Cost \$370 per child. We can restructure our payment schedule to assist families to budget for fee payments.
