Given the unpredictability of the weather, students may choose to wear their summer or winter uniform until May 6th (Week 4). From Monday 6th May, all students must wear full winter uniform. Students are only to be in their sport uniform on the days that they have Physical Education. As students transition into winter uniform, it is an opportune time to visit Fil in the uniform shop if your child is in need of additional items to prepare for the cooler weather. It is an expectation that students will always be in the correct uniform. Please refer to photos of the correct school uniform for winter.

On Tuesday afternoon at our school assembly Jake Maiorano spoke with students, staff and families about bullying. An **Upstander** is someone who takes action against bullying behaviour and that is exactly what Jake did! The message delivered by Jake was loud particularly when he stated "Show respect to your fellow students and stamp out bullying. We all need to do-our part to stop it. If you see something happening, don't be a bystander, say something! Together we can make a difference. Say no to bullying!"

Our next Assembly is on Tuesday the 30th of April








2024 PSG SCHEDULE UPDATE



Dear Families,

In alignment with recommendations from Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic School personnel, our 2024 PSG scheduling is changing.

In Term 1 and 3, PSGs will take place for students who receive **substantial** or **extensive** levels of adjustments (and those new to the caseload). This means that some students who may have had a PSG each term, will not be scheduled to have one in Term 1 and 3, in 2024.

We value your collaboration, and you will still receive the updated ILP for your child (including recent progress scores/comments) VIA EMAIL and of course, should you ever have any questions or concerns, please contact your child's classroom teacher.

If your child has an ILP, you should expect an email from your child's teacher before the end of Week 1, Term 2.

When you receive the email from the teacher, it is important you kindly:

- open the email and read any attached ILP.
- contact the class teacher ONLY if you have any further suggestions, questions or queries about the ILP.
- ☑ reply to the email from the teacher stating I have read and agree.
- Please email Emma Hinss to provide any important updates (e.g. family matters, changes to specialists, changes to medication/medical needs/ updated reports/assessments you may have received/progress in regard to specialist waitlists, details of new specialists that have started to work with your child since we last met).
- Please feel free to email <u>principal@ccglenroy.catholic.edu.au</u> or <u>ehinss@ccglenroy.catholic.edu.au</u> if you wish to schedule a PSG.

Please also be advised that PSGs will be held as per normal (for all students receiving adjustments) in Term 2 and 4.

Thank you for your ongoing support and collaboration. We look forward to meeting with you towards the end of Term 2 and Term 4.

2024 CORPUS CHRISTI SCHOOL FEES & LEVIES

Unfortunately as costs of living continue to increase in providing educational resources and facilities MACS have had to schedule a fee increase to meet the ongoing cost of providing Catholic Education in the Glenroy Parish. In consultation with our Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic School (MACS) Finance Business Partner we have tried to keep the fee increase minimal (but realistic in meeting our financial needs) so as not to increase financial hardship on families. An overall increase of 5% will be implemented for 2024. Thank you for your continued cooperation and understanding.

TUITION LEVY FEE FAMILY SCHOOL FEE

\$385 per student \$960 Family school Fee 2024 Year 5/6 Camp will be held at Don Bosco Camp at Safety Beach and Cost \$370 per child. We can restructure our payment schedule to assist families to budget for fee payments.




