Dear Corpus Christi Families,

Due to Fawkner Leisure Centre still undergoing renovations we will be conducting our Swimming and Safety Program at Elite Swimming Pool in Pascoe Vale. It will be run over four days in Week 8 beginning Monday the 25th of November to Thursday the 28th of November. This is an intensive swimming program whereby the children attend swimming each day for 4 days.

Water safety and swimming is a part of the Health and Physical Education curriculum.

Foundation – Children are introduced to basic safety and survival procedures in and around the water.

Years 1 and 2 – Children explore different ways to move into, through, and out of water safely.

Years 3 and 4 – Children develop their knowledge and understanding of water safety, and extend their swimming and survival abilities.

Years 5 and 6 – Children improve their survival abilities and safety techniques in the water, extending their range of swimming skills to include those required for clothed, survival swimming.

The aim of educating the children with regards to swimming and water safety is to enable them to safely enjoy aquatic activities in a range of environments.

Each child in the school is expected to attend swimming classes as it is a part of the school curriculum. If your child has private swimming lessons please ask the swimming centre, where your child attends, to issue them with a certificate stating their current level of swimming competence so that they can be grouped accordingly. For efficiency of time it is best for children to wear their bathers to school under their uniform or sports uniform.

A plastic bag or beach bag with your child's name clearly marked and containing:

- A towel
- Underwear
- Googles
- Brush or comb
- A bag to place their wet items in

In following Child Safety guidelines, Parents will not be permitted to enter the change rooms and assist in dressing their child or others. It is important prior to the swimming program commencing that students, especially the junior children are capable of drying and dressing themselves independently.

The proposed timetable for the Swimming program is as follows:

9:15-10:00 am: Year F/1 class + Year 5/6 (split class) 10:00-10:45 am: Year F/1 class + Year 5/6 (split class)


10:45-11:30 am: Year 2/3 class 11:30-12:15 pm: Year 2/3 class 12:15-1:00 pm: Year 4 class 1:00-1:45 pm: Year 5/6 1:45-2:30 pm: Year 5/6

Students will be travelling by bus and further details on when the first group will need to be at school will be communicated through Storypark and the Newsletter in the coming weeks.

The Year 4 students have been invited to attend Penola Catholic Secondary College (Junior Campus on Friday 22nd November between 9am-2.00pm to familiarise students with what Penola offers as a Secondary College to assist in making decisions about Secondary school in 2027. Students will be involved in a number of rotational activities to experience some high school subjects and will be provided with a sausage sizzle lunch.


