Dear Corpus Christi Families,

I felt so privileged to be with the students, staff and community members at our Beginning of School Year Mass. The reverence, participation and spirit shown by the students of Corpus Christi made me so proud. I knew this was a special place, but Wednesday's Mass left me with absolutely no doubt just how special it is and how hard I, and all of us, must work to maintain that.

NAPLAN

It is around this time of the year where the media will start talking about NAPLAN and shops will start selling NAPLAN preparation materials. NAPLAN is a set of assessments that students in Year 3, 5, 7 and 9 from all over Australia complete in March of each year. The data is used by the Government and other educational bodies to check in on the health of our Education system. For individual students, NAPLAN is a snapshot of how they are performing at the partial moment in time

At Corpus Christi students will complete NAPLAN spaced over a number of days so that the experience is not a stressful one and is as close to possible as the testing students complete in class on a regular basis. We will prepare students for NAPLAN by doing some practice tests and a little bit of revision but we will not 'cram' years worth of learning into a short period of time. This does nothing to help students and in some cases gives us data that is not accurate. We want an accurate picture of the learning and teaching that has occurred at Corpus Christi to inform our future direction and plans.

COMMUNITY ROOM

Our Community room is open every morning, if you have time to spare this is a great opportunity to relax for a little while and have a cuppa and a chat with other community members. We are looking forward to seeing you there.

TRAFFIC/GATES

For the safety of all in our community, I remind you that it is important that road rules are followed at all times near our school. It is illegal and very dangerous to double park and let children out of a car that is not parked in a designated car spot. It is also extremely important that when crossing the road the designated school crossing is used.
