Incredibly we are over half way through Term 1! As a community we have experienced some great days already with even more exciting events to come!

NAPLAN

Students in Years 3 and 5 will complete NAPLAN testing over the next two weeks. NAPLAN is a set of assessments that students in Year 3, 5, 7 and 9 from all over Australia complete in March of each year. The data is used by the Government and other educational bodies to check in on the health of our Education system. For individual students, NAPLAN is a snapshot of how they are performing at the partial moment in time.

Students will complete the Writing Assessment on Wednesday 12th March, the Reading Assessment on Friday 14th March, Conventions of Language Assessment (Spelling, Grammar, Punctuation etc) on Monday 17th of March and the Numeracy Assessment on Tuesday 18th March. Catch up test may be completed on Friday 21st of March.
