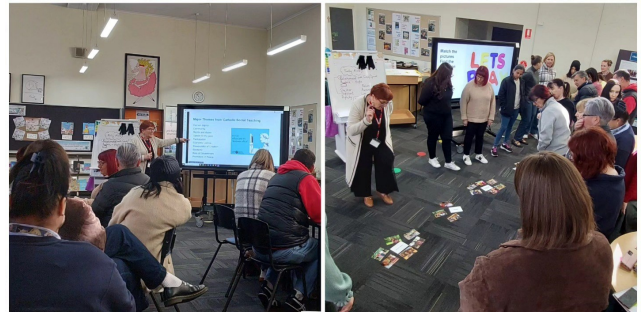
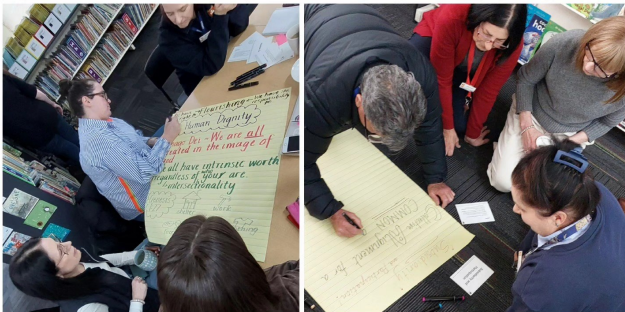
The 2024 Annual Report to the School Community is now available on our website. We encourage you to take a moment to read through and celebrate the accomplishments of the past year with us.
