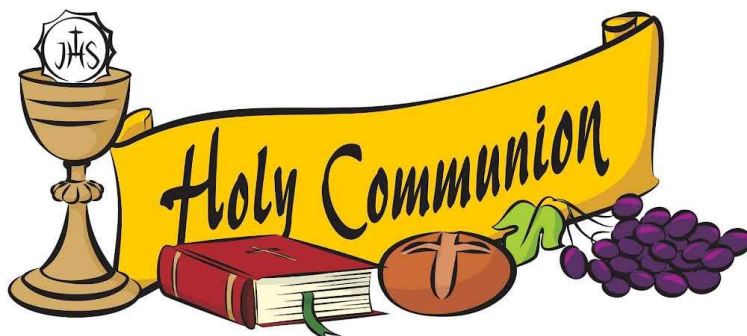
We are grateful for the strong partnerships we share with our families and parish community, which help make Corpus Christi such a welcoming and vibrant place for all.
