Dear Corpus Christi Families,

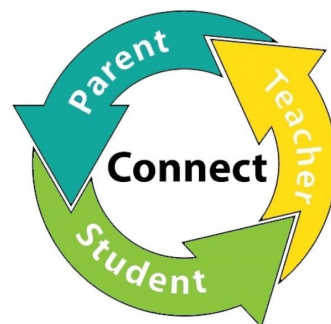
