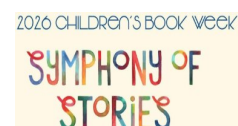

PRINCIPAL'S DAY

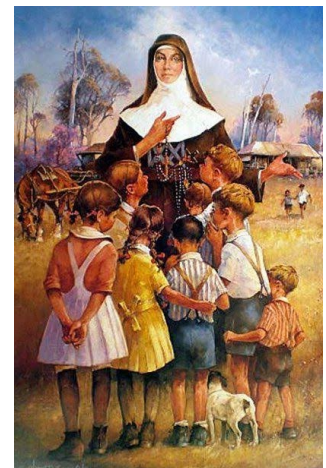
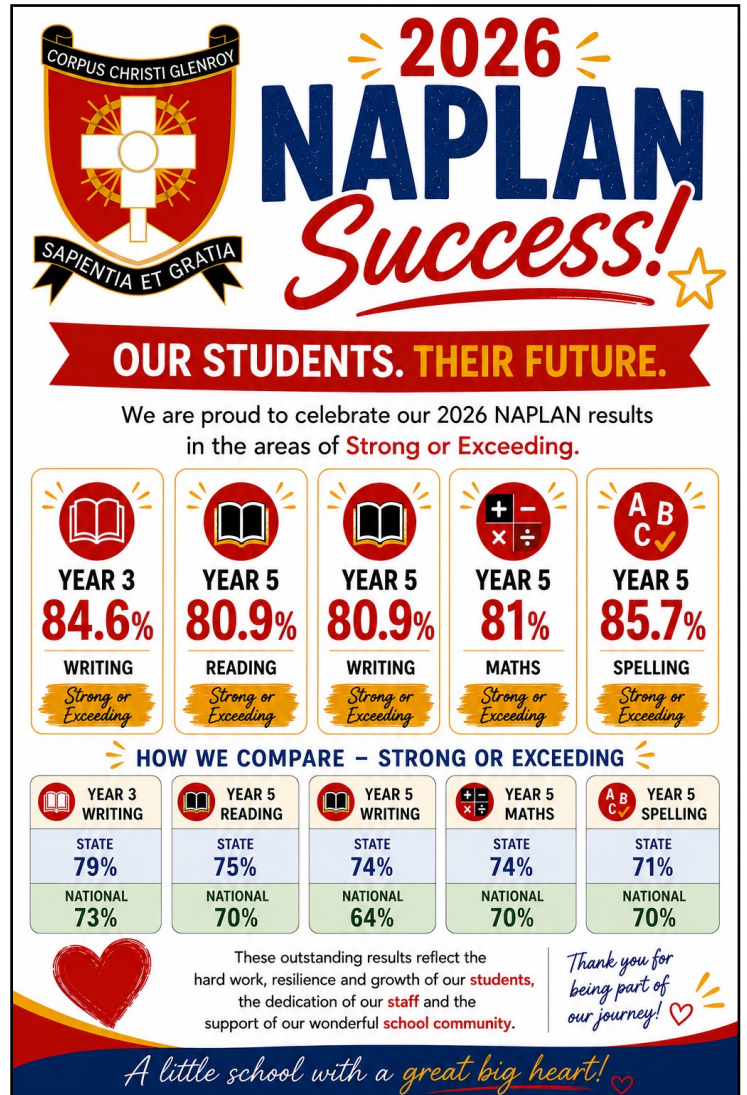
Today we celebrate Australian Principal's Day. I would like to sincerely thank our wonderful school community for the many kind messages, cards and well wishes I have received.

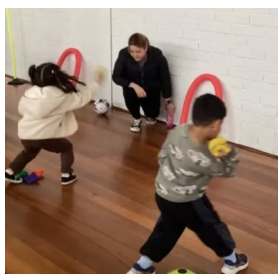
Dear Corpus Christi Families,
